Vacancies for the Post of Engineer

The Metro Express Ltd (MEL) is a newly registered Mauritian Company wholly owned by Government of Mauritius. MEL is responsible to develop, finance, construct, operate and manage the Metro Express light rail system in Mauritius.

2. MEL invites applications from suitably qualified candidates for employment, on a contractual basis, as Engineer, for an initial period of two years including one year's probation.

Qualifications

3. Candidates should:

- a) be registered as a Professional Engineer of Mauritius (or equivalent recognised international standing) in the fields of civil, electrical or mechanical engineering with the Council of Registered Professional Engineers of Mauritius under section 13 of the Registered Professional Engineers Council Act no 49 of 1965, and as subsequently amended;
- b) have at least 10 years' post registration experience in the management and integration of civil-electrical-mechanical works preferably in the field of road and/or rail transportation including contract management and design management;
- c) be computer literate and able to operate engineering software packages; and

- d) be conversant with International Federation of Consulting Engineers (FIDIC) conditions and forms of contracts.

Role and Responsibility

4. The main role of the Engineer will be the overall management of the contracts with respect to the Metro Express Project in order to ensure that the Contractor and the Consultants meet all their obligations. The Engineers will report to the Project Director and/or Management/Chairman of Metro Express Ltd.

Duties

- a) To assist in the supervision, monitoring and general management of the Metro Express Project
- b) To ensure oversight over contractors, subcontractors, consultants and coordination among all stakeholders
- c) To liaise and follow up with authorities, departments and private owners for wayleaves, whenever required
- d) To prepare and submit progress reports, briefs and notes at regular intervals and as and when required for the Board and the Monitoring Committee
- e) To analyse documents/reports submitted by Contractor/Consultant and any other agency and advise Metro Express Ltd on proper course of action
- f) To participate in meetings, committees including site meetings.
- g) To process and recommend payments of claims, wherever necessary

- h) To thoroughly document all aspects of the Project to ensure that the interests of Metro Express Ltd are protected
- i) To monitor progress on Metro Express Project and recommend corrective action, as and when required
- j) To check that all deliverables submitted by Consultants are in conformity with the Terms of Reference and Scope of Works
- k) To perform all other duties directly related to the Metro Express Project to ensure its successful implementation, as may be assigned by the Management/Board

5. Salary is negotiable based on qualifications and experience.
